## Profile of The Alma Singers

The Alma Singers were formed in 1977 and celebrate their 40th anniversary in 2017. This four voice choir perform concerts mainly in the Sale and Altrincham areas, which are public and private events and for charity organizations. The choir raises around £1000 per year, most recently for Parkinson's UK (Trafford Branch) and Timperley Country Fair, Henshaws Society for blind people, CRUK and CL1C Sargent

The choir is directed by Margaret Curzon, a freelance peripatetic teacher, who also directs several primary school choirs in the local area. Tony Heaton, the accompanist, has been associated with the choir for many years.

The choir repertoire is wide ranging, covering 15th to 21st century music, including madrigals, choral music, music from the shows and the modern classics.

The choir arranges open rehearsals at intervals to attract new members in all voice categories.



The annual Christmas concert, in December, at the United Reformed Church, Whitefield Road, Sale, is a fund raising concert for the choir.
